
0+3 Quarantine Arrangements for Inbound Persons

from Overseas Places and Taiwan





Before	
departure	



Conducted within 24 hours prior to the scheduled time of departure with a negative result (can be self-administered or by professional swab sampling)



- Including declaration of pre-departure RAT result
- Inbound persons who have fulfilled vaccination requirement are recommended to declare their vaccination records in order to comply with the requirement to be issued the Provisional
- Non-Hong Kong residents aged 12 or above are required to fulfill vaccination requirement



Boarding requirement(s) for verification by airlines

• Present green Health Declaration QR code (which can be a downloadable version of the QR code, a screen shot or a printout)

Medical surveillance

- Observe the conditions specified in the Notification of **Medical Surveillance**
- Subject to **Amber Code restrictions** under **Vaccine Pass**
- Undergo daily **RATs**, and **negative results should be** confirmed before leaving the place of residence
- On Day 2, undergo PCR-based nucleic acid test^ after obtaining negative result of RAT on the day
- Those who are consecutively tested negative can complete medical surveillance with Amber Code restrictions ending at 9 a.m. of Day 3

Self-monitoring

- · Monitor health condition, including taking body temperature twice daily
- Take appropriate personal disease prevention measures including wearing a mask and maintaining hand hygiene
- Undergo daily **RATs**, and **negative results should be** confirmed before leaving the place of residence
- On Days 4 and 6, undergo PCR-based nucleic acid tests^ after obtaining negative results of RATs on respective days





The handling arrangements for persons <u>tested positive</u> will be aligned with that for local cases

- Vaccine Pass will be switched to Red Code
- · Please provide information to the Centre for Health Protection through the online platforms (for nucleic acid tests or RATs)
- If the household environment is not suitable for isolation or the original hotel is not available for on-site isolation, inbound persons tested positive would be sent to Community Isolation Facility or Community Isolation Hotel
- except inbound persons aged below three years old
- Inbound persons aged three years old or above on the date of arrival at Hong Kong have to undergo PCR-based nucleic acid testing by professional swab sampling at **Community Testing Centres** or **mobile specimen** collection stations (for free), or at recognised local medical testing institutions (self-paid), as specified in the relevant testing requirement above
