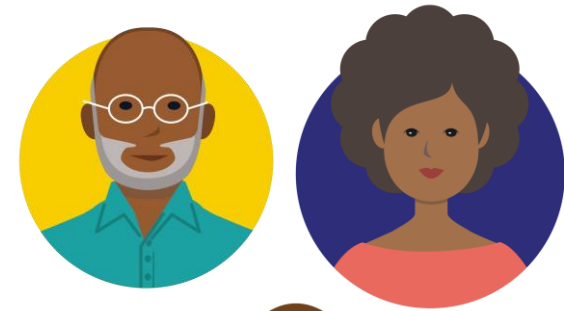

- Parents, guardians or responsible adults must create and keep the UKVI account up to date for children under 18. They can do this as a 'proxy' which means they can assist with creating a UKVI account, accessing the child's eVisa, and managing any immigration application.

- Everyone with an eVisa must have their own UKVI account, including dependants and children under 18.
- Parents, guardians or responsible adults must create and keep the UKVI account up to date for children under 18. They can do this as a 'proxy' which means they can assist with creating a UKVI account, accessing the child's eVisa, and managing any immigration application.
- From early next year, children and dependants without their own UKVI account may experience inconvenience and delays when travelling to the UK as additional checks may be required to confirm their UK immigration status, and carriers may deny boarding.

- To create an account for a child, the proxy will need access to the child's identity document and will be prompted to select that they are creating the account on behalf of someone else. Accounts can be created for multiple children in the same way, using the same email address and phone number.
- The proxy can transfer ownership of the UKVI account and access to the online services to the child when they turn 18.
